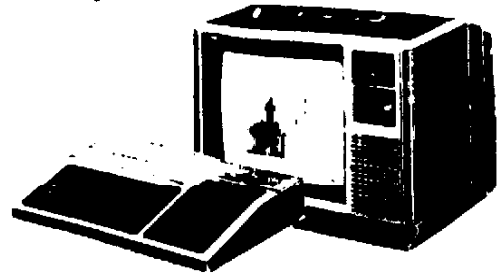

A special thanks to John and Malcom Bender for their efforts in making the bulk diskette purchase a success.

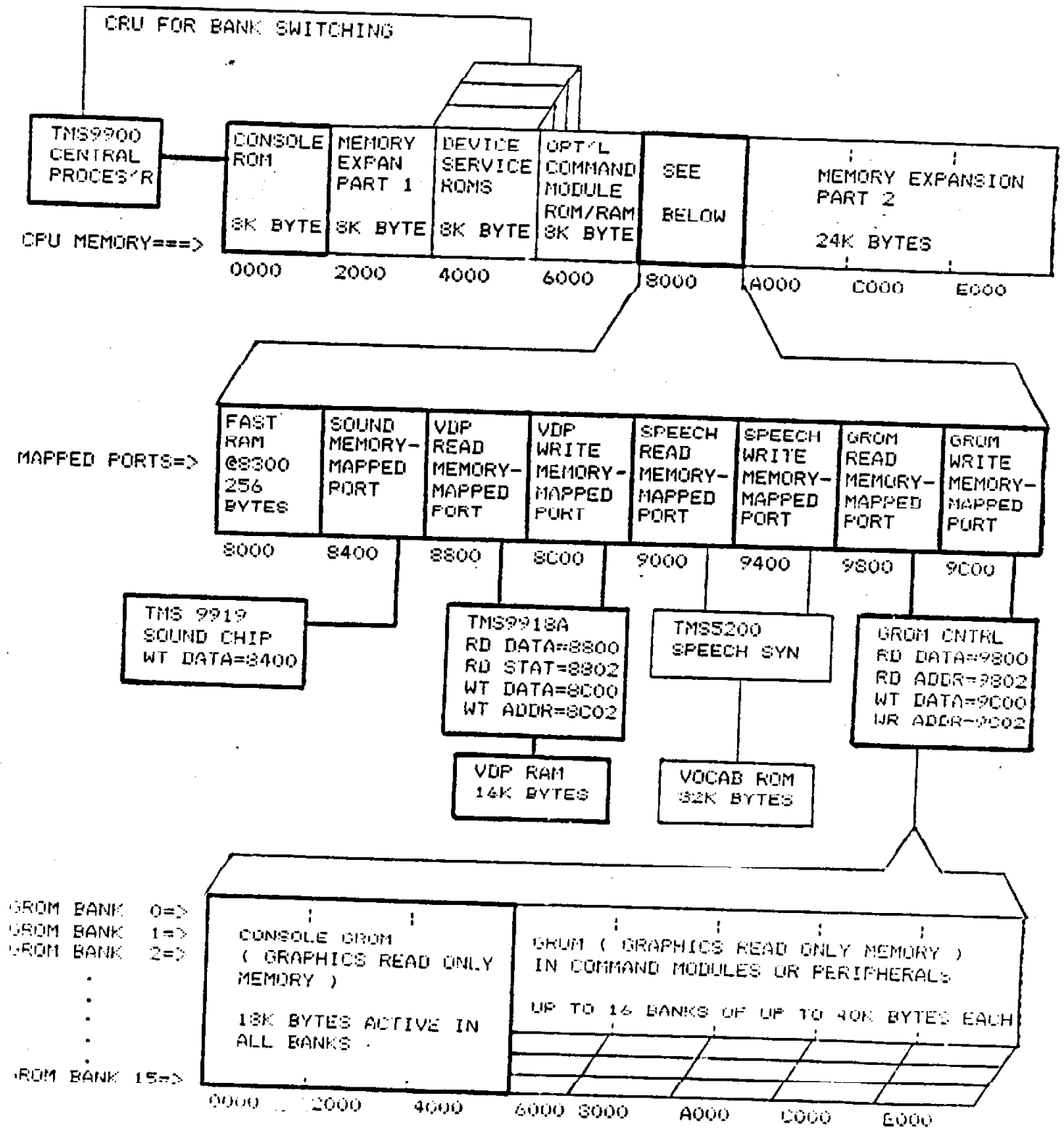
