ED.Echoes, June/July 89

Well, I really thought that I had already typed in a partial page for the next newsletter, but since I can't find it on a disk anywhere I have to assume this was merely a mental fog on my part! Oh well....

For the N/L to get out this month, or should I say "months", since I intend to do only ONE for "June and July", I am going to have to depend on copied material, since typing is quite a chore at this time, requiring enough of my (limited) supply of mental energy and attention to detract from any compositional efforts. Usually my TYPING of what my brain is thinking is "transparent", but just lately has been a real chore, since I am using only my right hand. I fell at work early in July and broke my left arm and have since discovered just how awkward the "qwerty" keyboard REALLY is, if you do not have two sets of fingers to use on it. Slows you down by Much more than a factor of 50% when you have to use only one hand!!

As part of this N/L, I am sending all the Exchange Groups a copy of our Mail-list of Exch Groups. The months which we have RECEIVED from each group are listed as months INITIALS in the last column, for 1988 and thru May of 1989.

H.U.G. meeting of June 11, 1989 was held, but I don't know what the program WAS, since I was not able to attend. And I almost missed the (re-scheduled) meeting of July 16th...at which there was a general discussion of the status of our TIBBS system, (which is now back up and working, thanks to Glenn Cox, new Sysop), and a demo by Bob McCarthy.

One thing that we are going to try to do is provide a "Disk of the Month" each month at the meetings. These will be some programs put together by Larry Pipkin, mostly from the library, grouped by type or subject, and pre-disked. Those of you who show up at the meeting with EITHER a blank disk to exchange for the DOM, OR with \$.50 to pay for the disk, can take it home and see what you got and what you can do with it! Those who do not make it will miss out on the "ten free programs" raffle and on the DOM, unless there are some left over and you get a disk to Larry later. The FIRST "DOM" disk will contain the following programs, more or less: "BOOT" and Docs; a couple of cataloger programs, a couple of label or disk-label programs, a program to test prime numbers; one to set your printer for various custom font settings, one to find the START name for D/F 80 programs (Ed./Assembler type 3); and a couple of Auto-Menu/Loader programs for disks of XR programs. Actually, the DOM is mostly the JUG group May 89 DOM, with programs by Phil Van Nordstrand added, and the Menu-loader programs by me.

I would assume that the Programme for the next meeting will be a "show and try it out" of the DOM disk...otherwise I don't know what it would be. I will not be there, as my August plans have been re-scheduled around the arm-in-a-cast, like NOT going to Pensacola beaches on my way to visit my family in Alabama. No, I am not from Alabama--my family is, though! Or if not from, at least TD! I WILL

make up the 25 copies of the DOM and give them to Bob McC., and it will be up to him to get them there and distribute and collect the "return" disks to come back to ME! AND hopefully to have (previously) tried them out so he can demo the disk and programs at the meeting.

P.S.: the DOM's will USUALLY not include much FREEMWARE, but if they DO just HAPPEN to have such a program on them and you just happen to like and use it, please consider taking the time to write and thank the author for his time and trouble in writing the program for you to use. But do it ANONYMOUSLY if you don't send him any money--he might pass through town someday and there is no use taking chances!

H.U.G. Board Meeting was held on July 25th at Ruth Herman's house, attended by Ruth, Bob McCarthy, Wayne Jobe, Glenn Cox, James Barnes, Larry Pipkin, and R. Lumpkin. Discussed the TIBBS, and how to support the costs of keeping it up, including new disk drives as needed; also the necessity of having advertising for the group and a Membership officer to keep contact with the members and make contact with prospective members. Donald McCord was contacted and has agreed to perform this vital function for the group. Also, it was decided to place another ad in the Greensheet for September.

Another question which came up at the Board meeting was whether we could have SIG (special interest groups) on subjects such as TIWriter, Multiplan, etc. Of course we COULD, if someone would sponsor and organize them. Actually a better name for these would be "common interests groups"--"CIG?" Sounds the same to me!

NEWEST competing "info-source" type service locally is called "PRODIGY", apparently jointly sponsored by SEARS and IBM. Very naturally, it ONLY is supported through software running on MS-DOS machines, but the cost is FIXED and relatively modest at \$9.95 per month. Article indicated that there are about 5 times as many data types or areas as through the BELL "Source-line", but which one proves to be more viable will probably be determined more by the U/U factor--Usability times Usefulness. Since for most subscribers the Bell service does NOT provide for the ability to PRINT the info as accessed, (only those running out of a "shell" with a screen dump), and because IBM knows more about computers and their users than Bell, and since Sears knows more about retailing services than Bell, I would have to predict that Bells system will become the odd-service-out. There is even ANOTHER service being TV advertised now--but I missed the name and distinguishing features, like WHO is doing it! Seems to use some sort of proprietary terminal, however, and no sign of a printer in the ad! certainly no DISK DRIVES visible! These people must have the same fuzzy marketing concepts and lack of use-concept that has plagued all attempts to create "services" for computer would-be users, where no such users existed. Once the novelty wears off, such devices and services either serve a true, desired USE, or else they don't get USED!!

FOLLOWING is a listing of the Users Groups with which H.U.G. (the Houston Users Group) exchanges (or has attempted to exchange with), or to which we send courtesy copies of our newsletter. The database in use is PRBASE vsn 2.1, and performs all necessary sorting based on either the first two digits of the Record (Status) or by zip code etc as necessary. We mail to the members one week before each meeting (well, USUALLY!) and to the exchange groups later.

EXCHANGING Groups seem to fall into two categories: those who are organized and send all or almost all months issues to us, either on time or bundled, and are labeled "EG" or "EF" for "exchange group" or "foreign exchange"; and those who do NOT send issues regularly, usually only 1 or 2 or 3 per year, and do not respond to repeated entreaties to let us know at least that they are receiving what we send. These are the same people who send us a newsletter and note announcing that they would like us to to 'exchange with them' when we have been sending to them for 8 months at three addresses, with cards and letters, WITH ABSOLUTELY NO ACKNOWLEDGEMENT on their part. These get a status of "E?" which means "exchange status uncertain, send issues to match the months which we RECEIVE!" (IF we receive any more, which often we do not, since they are not organized in the first place!). NO I am NOT perfectly organized, but I CAN tell you what newsletters we have received during the last 18 months, and pretty accurately just what months were SENT to all groups also! More on this later.

There are two other types we send to: groups who cannot afford a NL and yet are a contributing part of the TI community, (and those individuals who meet the same criteria). These are labeled "EC" for "courtesy exchange" status. And last but not least, those groups for whom we come up with an address, from MANY SOURCES, who are prospective exchangers; we have met some of our best 'friends' this way. The trial mailings are labeled as status "ET" for "Exchange Trial", logically enuf, and usually either become a "EG" or else a "NG" after three months. Sometimes they fall through a period of being "E?" until we decide whether they are going to send regularly or not. "NG" stands for "non-exchanging group", simply enough.

SOOD, simply Sorting the index gives me all the codes with Status "E?" arranged alphabetically, then the "EC" Groups, then the "EG" groups, then the "EF" Groups, each section alphabetically by group name, since my Record FIELDS are: Status, Name, Address, etc... This makes it very convenient when names are added or statuses changed--they automatically fall into the correct grouping, on the next Index and Sort.

The last FIELD on each Record is a message field which prints on the mailing labels; I use it for messages to members ('TIME TO REMEM') AND on the exchange groups I keep a running record of THE NEWSLETTERS RECEIVED FROM THAT GROUP: JFMAXJ--SOMX/JFAXX for instance, where the x indicates a missing month, and -- indicates that group does not publish for that month. Preceding is typical performance of a good exchange group. JxxxxxAxxxx/Jxxxx is typical of groups we can't count on, for whatever reason. Sometimes they CAN and DON'T, sometimes they CAN'T, and sometimes it seems they CAN but WON'T. Sometimes address changes are the problem--again, a good upkeep on the data base helps with this, but if the persons RECEIVING the NLS and the persons SENDING out the Newsletter are not the same, a change on a groups address takes a while to get incorporated. I would recommend that

1) A WRITTEN LOG OR LIST OF EXCHANGE GROUPS be kept and ALL NEWSLETTERS RECEIVED BE LOGGED IN by checking off months, BEFORE THE NL'S ARE PLACED INTO FILES for members use. IF THIS IS KEPT BY ZIP CODE ORDER, ANY ADDRESS CHANGES BY A GROUP will show up immediately, since this will usually be a DIFFERENT ZIP CODE from the one on the list. You can then flag the MAIL-LIST for update.

2) ANY TIME YOUR GROUP CHANGES 'TARGET' ADDRESSES for NL mailed to you, let the exchange groups KNOW with a note stapled to each issue for a couple of months. DON'T assume they will notice a changed Return Address on a label, or on an envelope, and don't assume that the person who opens the envelope will tell the person who is supposed to be mailing out to your group!
