Some of this letter (AND EVEN more in the future) is being prepared using the MY-Word Word processing program on the Myarc Geneve 9640 computer. The speed and power of it is phenomenal. I could keep over 8,000 80-column lines in memory! All of the format codes are embedded in the text and many new one-step key presses really make it nice. Be sure to see it in acTION at a meeTING. It makes a powerful partner to the Microsoft Multiplan program upgrade in 80-columns with super fast RECALC and enough space for a full 63 column by 255 row spreadsheet. More to come from Myarc in the future, too! The MDOS operATING system that I have now shines with many great commands using the same syntax as MS-DOS or PC-DOS and F-A-S-T-E-R than anything you've yet seen, except on an enormously more costly machine. It runs the TI cartridges too, with a GPL loader which will execute them at five different speeds. On speed "5" they run about 4-6 Times faster than you can think. You should try PARSEC on "5"!

Well you can tell that I'm excited about this machine and all of its possibilitIes. It is a speedy companion to the 99/4A world and with more improvements to come, it should establish its own special niche. Special thanks to Jack Riley of MYARC, Inc.
