

TIRED OF NUMBERS IN A COLUMN LINED UP BY THE FIRST DIGIT PATHER THAM THE LAST DIGIT OR THE DECIMAL? TRY THE FOLLOWING SUBROUTINE:

500 REM R.J. SUBROUTINE 510 IF POS(STR&(RUN),".",1) THEN 520 PRINT TAB(T-LEN(STR&(RUN))); STR&(RUN) 530 RETURN 540 PRINT TAB(T+1-POS(STRB(RUN)) .",1));STR&(RUN) 550 RETURN

AMITIME, IN THE PODY OF THE PROGRAM. YOU WISH TO PRINT A RIGHT-JUSTIFIED NUMBER (SPECIFIED OR CALCULATED),

LET RUN EQUAL THAT NUMBER, LET T EQUAL THE COLUMN TO CONTRIN THE DECIMAL. AND 603UB 500. NOTE THAT THIS SUBROUTINE HANDLES INTEGERS, DECIMALS, ZERO, AND NEGATIVE NUMBERS.
