
## DALLAS TI HOME COMPUTER GROUP

The FORTH system has been written in 9900 Assembler and functions somewhere between Pascal and assembly language in speed and readability. His demonstrations were super and included both complex music and high speed graphics. The finale consisted of both music and graphics programs sharing the screen at the same time that the FORTH assembler was assembling a program.
