You can have the messages appear approximately centered on the screen without all that tedious character and space counting, let the computer do it. That's what you got it for!

INTELLITEC ICS 1000 MEMORY EXPANSION CARD REVIEW

With TI getting out of the Home Computer business and the reported shortage of II memory expansion cards left in the market place, anyone who wants to expand the capabilities of the 99/4A must on to a third party supplier. Intellited Computer Systems of Murry, Utah offers an attractive price on both a stand alose and peripheral expansion box card memory expansion system. The stand alone unit is priced at \$130 and the card is \$95.

I purchased the card and received it in less than a week. I have found it to generally work well. Since, it is a "bare" card, i.e. no metal case, such as cards for the apple II, it does lack shielding. This generally is not a problem because the other cards in my peripheral expansion box are well shirlded. I have found through experimentation that the best slot to use with this card is \$3, with my other cards (except the box control card) as far away from the genory card as possible. This seems to have solved the occasional los: of memory I experienced with extensive editing of programs. It appears that my problems were due to originally using slot #7, right next to the disk controller card and the disk drive. The beavy magnetic field and distance from the cooling fan appears to have been the cause of my memory loss problem.

Overall, I am happy with the Intellitec Memory Expansion Card, and have found it a good buy. It has worked with all the software that can access the memory expinsion, that I have tried.

MY enthusiasum runs-over greatly for the TI-COMPACT CCMPUTER 40. Everyone interested in figures more than words should get it! This lil gem is for: College Science or Business Majors, Engineers, architects, Insurance Agents Claims Adjusters, Investment Tax Minded People, Bank Loan Officers, Real Estate Brokers, Builder Developers, etc. However, the Wafer Tape, Printer, and RS232 are not available yet, so I thought: "Since the CC-40 doesn't go dead when you turn-it-off, but only sleeps; MHY CAN'T IT BE FILLED TO CAPACITY WITH THE THINGS I USE MOST? (the light)

Now the importance of 'MENU FORMATING" or DECISION TREE PROGRAMING really struck home. Especially for those who bot the bargain TI-99/4A with Casset:e Recorders, this same principle, FILL-UP-THE-CONSOLE makes sense. It takes the tediousness out of locating loading good but short programs.

It has been said: "Little People talk about The Meather...Average People talk about Other People...Above Average People talk about Ideas." Mell, sy psychiatrist had the idea that he manted a "Tern Key Computer Sytem because "Programing Mas Too Dificult To Learn." I knew him to be a rugged individualist that would want some changes in any program he could buy. He confirmed this, so I asked him how he would go about writing a book, or a scientific Theme Type Paper? His answere was, "I MOULD COLLECT A WHOLE BUNCE OF NOTES." Then his wife, sharp as a tack, entered in with: "I WOULD MAKE AN OUTLINE!" Of course they were both right, but I pass along the conversation in the hope that it may help you, as it did me.

HOW DO YOU DO IT? Locations 16 to 166 reserved for Titles of Books or Theme, and a YES/80 decision ending each title line by a prompt. Carry-on with this idea of FILL-UP-THE-CONSOLE while sipping coffee as OLD CS1 does its 3-4 minute grind. It ADDS USE FRIDE TO PROGRAMING. (Be sure to test BYTES LEFT via: LINE 1 A=A+1 LINE 2 60 SUB 1 and RUM until "MEMORY FULL IN 1 appears on Screen. Then PRINT A and RUM for BYTES LEFT. Either Delete Lines 1 2 after Testing Memory Left, or Insert REM. I would love to tell you about the portable TI COMPACT COMPUTER 48 at a later date, as it can be Programed Easily from TI-99/44 EXTENDED BASIC.
